## Jumping

Class twelve	Best Kaimanawa style 40 cm's (Beginners only) (no jump off)
Class thirteen	Best Kaimanawa Free for all 40 cm's (Beginners only)
Class fourteen	Best Kaimanawa style 60 cm's (open) (no jump off)
Cass fifteen	Best Kaimanawa Free for all 60 cm's (open)

*Note: Heights may be lowered to suit abilities of horse and rider. Please advise judge. Give the jumping a go, its good practice for you.*

All dogs on a lead.

Plaiting is the norm, but a nice tidy mane will be accepted
